


















Battle of The Wilderness (Orange Turnpike) - May 5, 1864, Shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry.




BATTLE MAP | American Battlefield Trust's map of the Battle of The Wilderness (Orange Turnpike), Virginia on May 5, 1864






BATTLE MAP | American Battlefield Trust's map of the Battle of The Wilderness, Virginia on May 6, 1864






Plan of Battle of Cold Harbor, Va. : June 1st and 3rd 1864





HISTORICAL MAP | Cold Harbor, Virginia on June 1 and 3, 1864, Position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry indicated.





Battle of Cold Harbor, June 1. Shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry.















Siege of Petersburg, capture of the Weldon Railroad, August 18–19, 1864. Shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry.










Battle of Hatcher's Run, February 5–7, 1865. Shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry.







Battle of Appomattox Court House - April 9, 1865. Shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry.




BATTLE MAP | American Battlefield Trust's map of the Battle of Appomattox Court House, Virginia on April 9, 1865

The regiment was mustered out of service July 1,1865 after being present for Lee's surrender at Appomattox Court House.




