






Battle of Antietam, Md. - September 17, 1862. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry






Battle of Fredericksburg, Va. – December 13, 1862. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry






Battle of Chancellorsville, Va. - April 30 – May 6, 1863. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry






Battle of Gettysburg, Pa. – July 1-3, 1863. First Day. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry






Battle of The Wilderness -May 5 - 6, 1864, Engaged both days. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry








North Anna Campaign Movements. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry






Battle of Cold Harbor -- May 31 to June 12, 1864. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry














Appomattox Campaign, Va., April 2 – 9, 1865.

Surrender in McLean House at Appomattox Court House, Va., 9 April 1865.








Grand Review of Armies, Washington, D.C., on May 23–24, 1865


