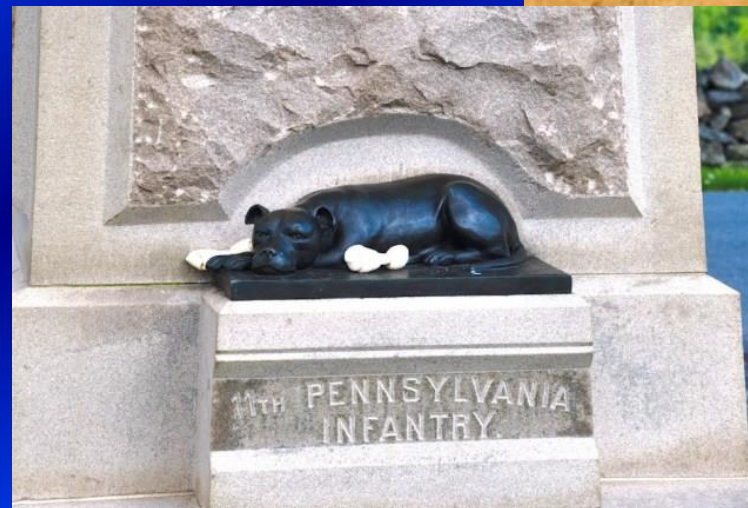

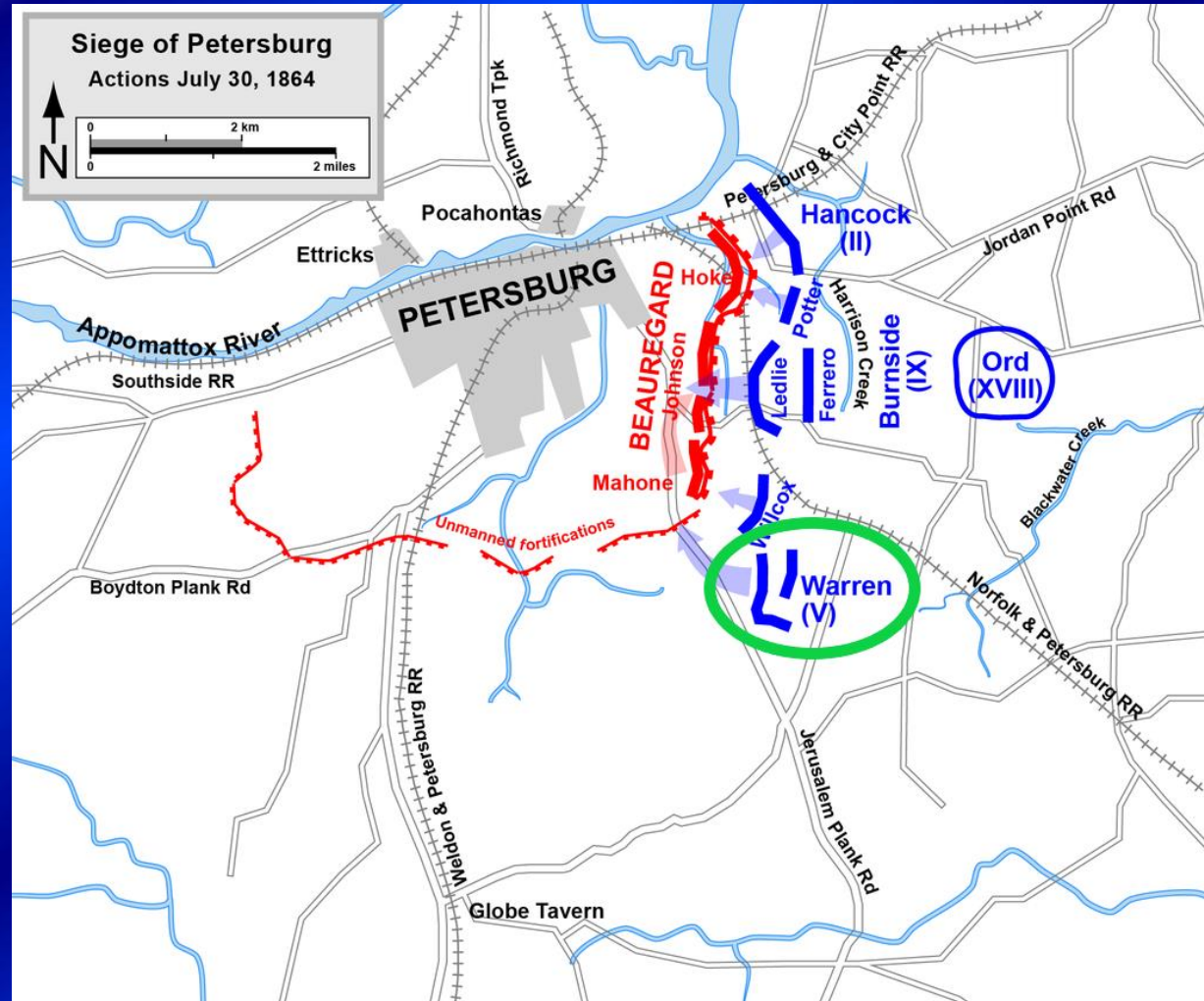
Battle of Cold Harbor -- May 31 to June 12, 1864. Map shows position of 11th Pennsylvania Infantry

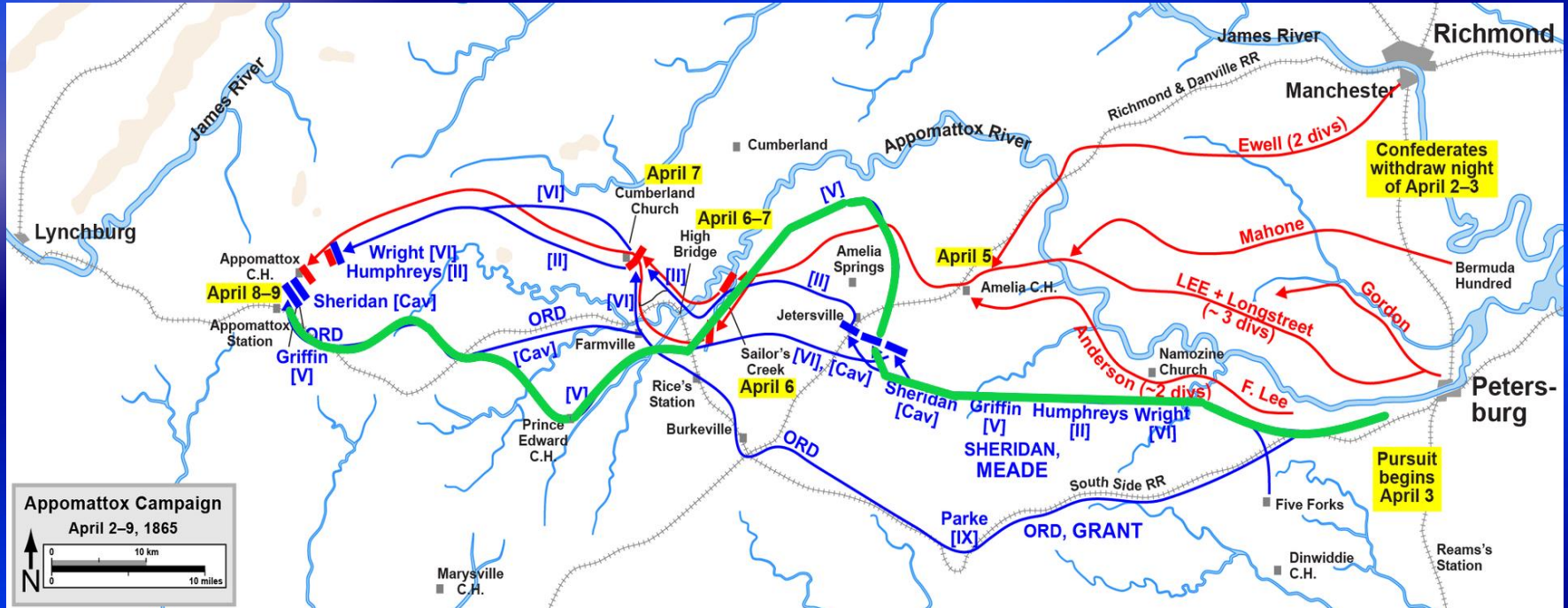

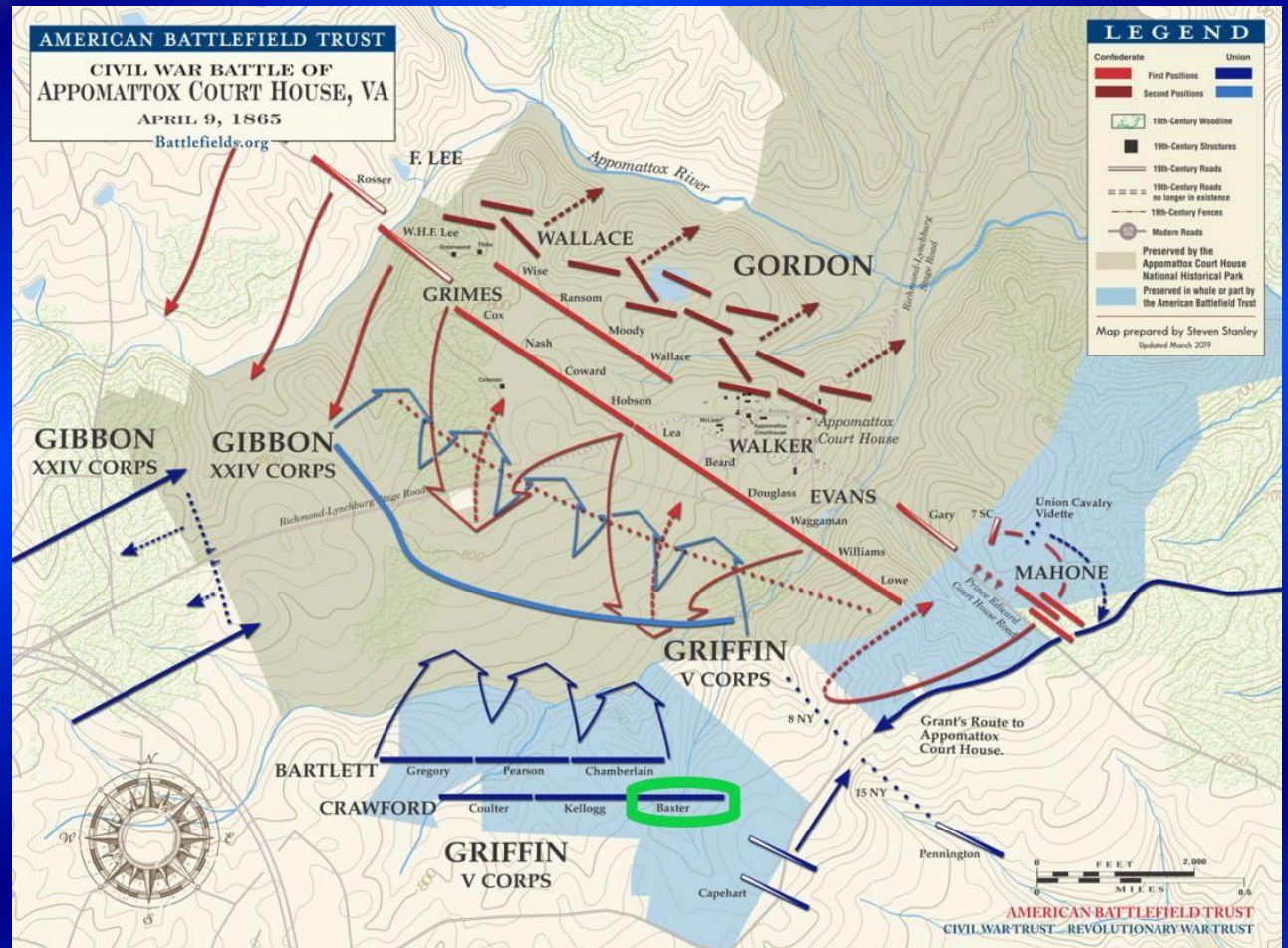

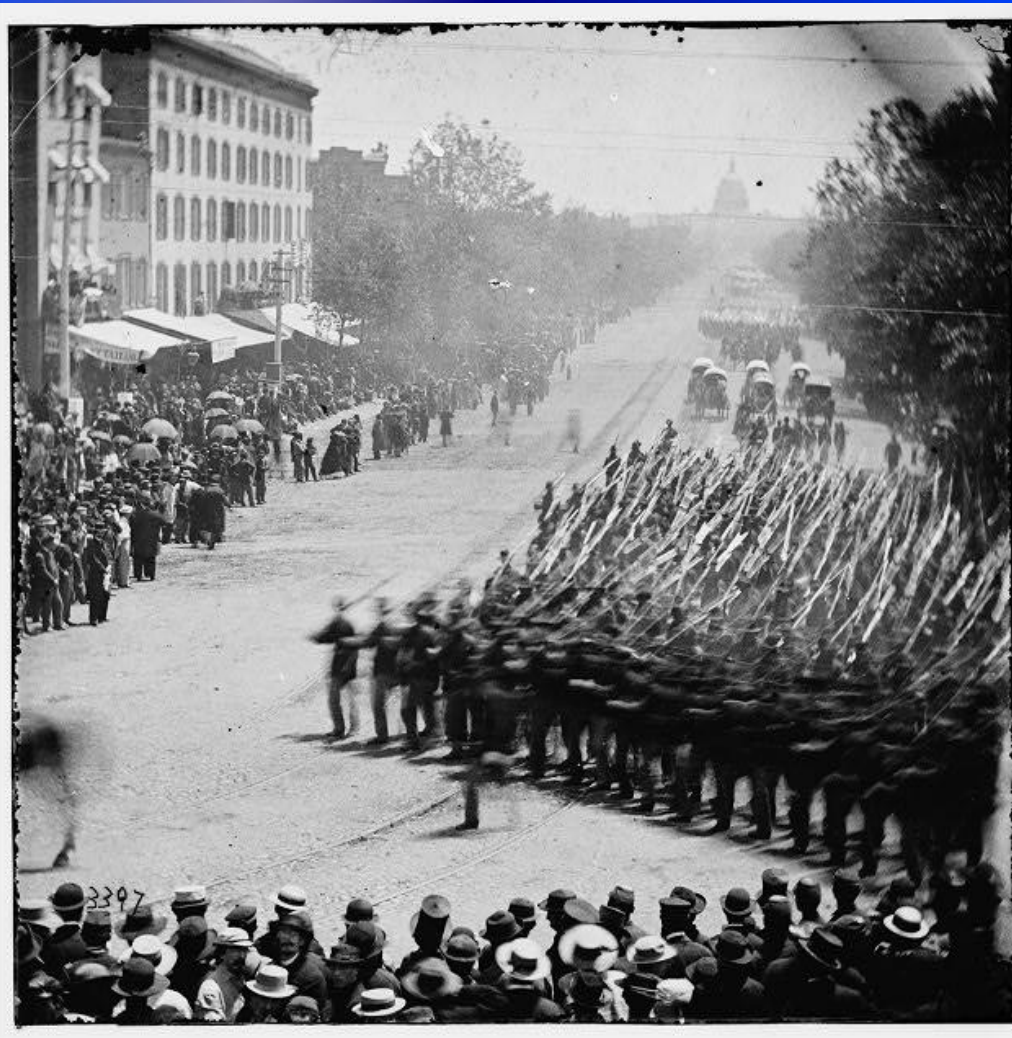
